GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF PROFFERED PAPERS

- 1. The proffered paper presentation is open to all systems with no theme and limited to radiology residents only.
- 2. Send the file as an attachment by email to iriatschapter@gmail.com
- 3. Mention following details in the attachment.
 - A. Presenting author name. The name of the presenting author should be underlined.
 - B. Co-authors: not more than 4 in number
 - C. Title:
 - D. Institution
 - E. Please indicate if your abstract needs to be considered for competition paper for Prof. T. Mandapal Gold Medal Award Yes/No.
 - F. The winner of the Prof. T. Mandapal Gold Medal Award will get award, certificate and refund of registration fees.
 - G. The second and third winners of Prof. T. Mandapal Gold Medal Award will get certificate and refund of registration fees.
- 4. If you wish to submit another abstract, kindly repeat the same steps.
- The presenting author must be a Provisional Student life member of IRIA and has to provide his membership number while submitting the abstract.
- 6. The abstract would be accepted only if the presenting author is registered for the conference.
 - The presentations should be full-fledged studies based on hypothesis driven research. They will be Power Point presentations of 8 minutes duration with 2 minutes for questions and discussion. The abstract for this category will have to be divided into: Objective, Material & Methods, Results & Conclusion
- 7. Presentation should be balanced and contain no commercial and promotional content.
- 8. Patient confidentiality should be protected. No names, hospital telephone numbers or any other identifying information can appear in presentation.
- 9. No changes in the abstract contents and the authorship will be allowed after the final submission. If you wish to withdraw your abstract after final date you must inform the scientific committee by e-mail only.
- 10. The scientific work submitted should be original and not previously presented at any national or international conference.
- 11. The decision of the scientific committee will be final.
- 12. Last date of abstract submission is 25th September, 2023.
- 13. It is mandatory to register before sending your abstract.



GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF SCIENTIFIC E-POSTERS

- All abstracts with any system and modalities can be sent by radiology residents only. The abstract should be in MS word format only.
- 2. Send the file as an attachment to e mail: iriatschapter@gmail.com
- 3. Mention following details in the attachment, as mentioned in the template in page 2
 - A. Presenting author name.
 - B. Co-authors: not more than 4 in number
 - C. Title:
 - D. Institution
- 4. If you wish to submit another abstract, kindly repeat the same steps.
- The presenting author must be a Life member/Provisional life member/ Associate member/Student member of IRIA and has to provide his membership number while submitting the abstract.
- 6. The abstract would be accepted only if the presenting author is registered for the conference.
- Presentation should be balanced and contain no commercial and promotional content.
- 8. Patient confidentiality should be protected. No names, hospital telephone numbers or any other identifying information can appear in presentation.
- 9. No changes in the abstract contents and the authorship will be allowed after the final submission. If you wish to withdraw your abstract after final date you must inform the scientific committee by e-mail only.
- The scientific work submitted should be original and not previously presented at any national or international conference, nor published.
- 11. The presentations can include full-fledged scientific studies or educational exhibits which highlight the spectrum of radiological findings of a disease entity, teach or review radiological signs, radiological-pathological correlation or describe an interventional radiological technique or a procedure, related to any modality and any system.
- 12. The decision of the scientific committee will be final.
- 13. Last date of abstract submission 25th September 2023.
- 14. It is mandatory to register before sending your abstract.
